

MBA Foundation Courses

The Masters in Business Administration program at Missouri State University requires 24 hours of foundation courses for students who do not have a business administration educational background. This foundation is composed of eight graduate-level courses which are designed to provide accelerated coverage of the knowledge base necessary for students to benefit most from the MBA curriculum.

ACC 500 Financial Accounting Concepts for Managers
CIS 500 Information Systems in Business Organization
ECO 500 Fundamentals of Micro- and Macroeconomics
FGB 500 Managerial Finance
MGT 500 Administrative, Organizational, and Operations Concepts for Managers
MKT 500 Marketing Concepts for Managers
RIL 500* Legal Environment for Business Managers
QBA 500 Statistical Methods in Business Research

Upon evaluation of baccalaureate degree transcripts, some or all of these courses may be waived, particularly for students holding an undergraduate degree in business.

Those considering entering the MBA program are encouraged to contact the MBA Program Director for a transcript analysis.
